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## SCOTCH WHISKY

### REGIONS OF SCOTLAND

Scotland's whisky-producing regions are as diverse as the wine regions of France. Each region produces single malt whiskies with distinct qualities & character, shaped by geography, climate, & centuries of established craftsmanship. The individual profiles of the Classic Malts reflect these clearly defined regional distinctions.

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### SPEYSIDE

Generally accepted as a subdivision of the Highlands region, Speyside is home to over half of Scotland's distilleries. Speyside malts are typically the sweetest of all Scotch whisky styles, & many of the world's most popular single malts originate from this region.

The extensive range of Speyside malts offers a wide variety of styles & is commonly grouped into two main categories: rich, full-bodied malts with pronounced sherry influences, & more delicate, complex malts characterised by light floral notes.

Speyside malts are predominantly sweet in character, although some expressions display a subtle peaty influence with a faint hint of smoke.

## SCOTCH WHISKY

### ISLAY

*There are eight distilleries on the island of Islay. Islay is located in the Inner Hebrides of Scotland. The island is often lashed by sea winds & rain, these elements certainly have a say in the whisky production, Islay's surface is very flat & consists largely of peat, which has a huge influence on the flavour of the whisky.*

*Islay whiskies are the strongest flavoured of all Scotch whiskies & tend to be dry & peaty. They are renowned for their strong peaty smokiness which comes from the peat fuel they use for malting the barley. The character of Islay malt whiskies are very often described as being very smoky & medicinal, salty & sea weedy with a dry finish & sometimes with a strong bite.*

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## SCOTCH WHISKY

### ISLANDS

*The Islands are not officially a whisky region, however, are another subdivision of the Highlands Region. The Islands are a geographical region rather than a characteristic one. The Islands region includes all of the whiskey producing Isles of Scotland namely Mull, Skye, Orkney, Arran, Jura & Lewis.*

*The Isle of Islay is considered a region on its own. Due to the location of the Islands distilleries, their whiskies tend to have a coastal feel. They are slightly peatier in character than most highland malts but not to the extent of the peatiness that you would find in Islay malts. The peatiness is generally softer & sweeter than their stronger cousins from Islay.*

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#### ARRAN BARREL RESERVE

*notes of orchard fruits, such as apple & pear, along with hints of vanilla, honey & gentle spices. The whisky has a creamy texture & a subtle sweetness, with a touch of oak from the aging process.*

#### TALISKER 10 YRS – ISLE OF SKYE

*rich dried fruit sweetness, clouds of smoke & strong barley malt flavours with a pepper twang.*

#### TOBERMORY 12 YRS

*a vibrant, fruity & spicy character with a subtle salty edge. The Hebridean single malt has sweet, honeyed aromas of vanilla, ripe oranges & delicate flowers.*

#### JURA 12 YRS – ISLE OF JURA

*rich & rounded, with an initial burst of barrel char halted by milk chocolate covered raisins & toffee sauce. The char rumbles along behind rising at the end with a plume of soft peat smoke.*

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### CAMBELTOWN

*Situated near the tip of the Mull of Kintyre peninsula on Scotland's west coast, Campbeltown was once home to more than 30 whisky distilleries. Today, only three remain in operation. Campbeltown single malts are highly distinctive - typically full-bodied & celebrated for their depth of flavour, with a subtle slaty finish. A gentle touch of peat adds a character reminiscent of Islay malts, while remaining uniquely Campbeltown.*

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#### GLEN SCOTIA

*a balance of sweet, fruity & coastal flavours, with varying levels of peat smoke & oak influence depending on the expression.*

## SCOTCH WHISKY

### LOWLAND

*The Lowland whisky region lies south of an imaginary line drawn from Greenock on Scotland's west coast to Dundee in the east. While most Lowland malts are destined for blending, a small number of single malts from the region are still available to enjoy.*

*Lowland whiskies are typically pale in colour with a light, dry finish. This dryness comes from the malt itself rather than peat, as Lowland malts are generally produced using unpeated barley. Subtle notes of sweet fruitiness are also common.*

*Mellow and approachable in style, Lowland malts are often regarded as excellent aperitifs. They are gentler than whiskies from the neighbouring Highlands & are appreciated both by newcomers to malt whisky & by seasoned enthusiasts.*

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#### AUCHENTOSHAN 12 YRS

*triple distilled then matured for over twelve years. Tempting aroma of toasted almonds, caramelised toffee & signature smooth Auchentoshan taste.*

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### HIGHLAND

*The Highlands are by far the largest of all Scotland's whisky-producing regions and offer the widest variety of styles. Many of the country's best-known distilleries are found here. On the mainland, the Western Highlands are home to only a small number of distilleries. Whiskies from this area are far less peaty than those of Islay, though a gentle hint of smokiness can often be detected. A common trait of West Highland malts is a sweet opening, followed by a dry finish.*

*In the far North Highlands, the character of the malt is strongly influenced by local soil conditions & the coastal setting of the distilleries. These whiskies are typically light-bodied, with a spicy profile & a dry finish, sometimes accompanied by a subtle salty note.*

*Malts from the Central, Southern, & Eastern Highlands display a broad range of styles. They are generally fruity & sweet—though less so than Speyside malts - & lighter in body. Like most Highland whiskies, they usually finish dry, making them balanced & approachable.*

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#### BALBLAIR 12 YRS

*part of the brand-new line up from Balblair, this 12-year-old returns the distillery to age statements as opposed to its vintage released. Matured in American oak ex bourbon casks, this Balblair is beautifully fresh & fruity, with lemon peel, creamy vanilla & a green apple aroma.*

#### DALWHINNIE 'WINTER'S FROST GAMES OF THRONES'

*Known for being one of the highest distilleries in all of Scotland: extreme conditions are responsible for shaping the signature Dalwhinnie Winter's Frost honeyed sweetness & spicy warmth.*

#### EDRADOUR 10 YRS

*Edradour is one of Scotland's smallest distilleries & at the heart of the range, this 10-year-old Eastern Highlander is a rather unique single malt, a decidedly rum-like dram with a thick mouthfeel.*

## AMERICAN WHISKEY

*This style of whiskey - as it is spelled in the United States - is often associated with notes of toast, spice, & vanilla sweetness. Much of this character comes from the extensive use of new charred oak barrels, which are predominant across most styles of American whiskey & are used exclusively in the production of bourbon. These barrels impart rich, sweet flavours such as vanilla & other aromatic compounds.*

*To be legally classified as bourbon, the mash bill must contain at least 51% corn, & the spirit must be aged in brand-new, charred white oak barrels. Rye whiskey, by contrast, is made from a mash bill dominated by rye grain, resulting in a whiskey that is notably spicier & often more complex in character.*

*tennessee whiskey is essentially a form of bourbon that undergoes an additional step known as the Lincoln County Process. This involves filtering the spirit through sugar maple charcoal before maturation, giving it a smoother profile. Kentucky straight whiskeys must also be aged in new, charred white oak barrels to be labelled straight bourbon. This requirement means that each barrel can only be used once for bourbon production.*

### BERNHEIM 7 YRS – KENTUCKY 21

*this Heaven Hill Distillery original is named for the famed Bernheim Distillery in Louisville. 7-Year Old wheat Whiskey, it is the first new style of American Whiskey to be introduced since Prohibition. Refreshingly smooth taste.*

### BURFFALO TRACE – KENTUCKY 18

*aromas of vanilla, toffee, & a hint of spice invite you in. The palate reveals layers of caramel, dark fruit, & a touch of oak, balanced by a smooth, warming finish.*
